Greetings! I will post quarterly updates to give the West End Community and those who love the West End an update on projects, events and exciting news.

Safety and Security

The Association approved a more comprehensive security plan submitted by my office called the West End Public Safety Program (WEPS) in December 2020. Phase one of WEPS was initiated on February 1, 2021 with new contract security officers from Tri-Shield Security & Investigations. We continued our partnership with the Dallas Police Department Extended Neighborhood Patrol Program (ENP). The ENP, Off-Duty DPD Police Officers, helped the neighborhood upon my arrival last November during the election and continued to support our security efforts thru January. They will continue to support our security efforts during some week day evenings and weekend night coverage. The security officers begun to cover business hours, Monday - Friday. I will work continue to work closely with the Dallas Police Department Central Patrol Division. Dallas Police is committed to provide world class services by including bike unit, mounted unit and DPD reserve corp patrols as the spring and summer months arrive. We plan to engage and provide input with the DPD's new city wide camera coverage program and bring to their attention the criminal activity we see in the West End such as the aggressive street racing and damage to property (ie. graffiti).

West End Square Park (Grand Opening)

Parks for Downtown successfully opened the West End Square last weekend! It has been exciting to see its creation and learn how the new park will bring our neighborhood together using its beautiful landscape and innovation. Citizens, visitors and daily workers will be able to enjoy the park during the daytime and evening hours. You will be able to enjoy lunch at a near by restaurant, take a break from a hard work day, walk your dog or have children enjoy the new swings. Our plan is to activate the park and the streets surrounding it so residents and visitors can enjoy all the West End has to offer.
